

Music Distribution Format - Options & Conditions of Use 2020

Chime Choir prioritises our compliance with copyright laws and we support composers, arrangers and artists to continue to compose music for us to use. Chime purchases licences for our music used during the performance year.

Choristers have 2 options to access music scores for the year's concert repertoire.

1. Digital Download

- You'll have access to a secure Dropbox from where you can download the music to your personal device. This can be used only on your device and won't be able to be printed. Digital scores files must not be redistributed to others.
- Your access of the Dropbox is via a personalised link registered to your email address. You undertake not to share this link and your access will be visible to Chime's dropbox administrator.
- Following the concert performance, the associated digital files will be removed from the Dropbox and you must undertake to delete them from your devices.

2. Printed Booklet

- Chime will produce a print copy of music for each term or potentially grouped together as a two-term semester.
- Should you elect to receive your repertoire scores in this printed booklet form, a registered personal copy will be provided on loan to you. Chime retains ownership of these score booklets.
- At the end of the semester, the printed scores must be returned to Chime.

The printing of repertoire booklets represents an additional cost for Chime. In recognition of this cost impact, a fee of \$10/booklet will be levied for those choosing the printed format, to partially offset the costs of printing.
